

Bachelor of Theology (Honours)/ Bachelor of Ministry (Honours)

Course Code BTh(Hons) 054679F, BMin(Hons) 054673A

One-year programs (max 2yrs part-time) following completion of the three-year Bachelor of Theology or Bachelor of Ministry which aim to prepare for advanced research in theology or ministry. Students focus on a designated field.

Admission requirements:

- Completion of BTh or BMin with a GPA of at least 2.0, with 2.8 in the designated field of study to be pursued.
- BTh(Hons): successful completion of at least 8 cps in Hebrew or Greek and at least 8 cps of biblical language exegesis in the initial degree.
- BMin(Hons): successful completion of at least 4 cps of biblical language in the initial degree.
- For candidates with a degree from other than ACT, there may be

bridging requirements (refer to the ACT Undergraduate Handbook).

Course Structure:

Coursework units:

- At least 8 cps of 400/700 level units in the student's designated field
- Research Methods
- One elective unit

[Note: all New Testament or Old Testament exegesis units will be biblical language units]

Research Thesis:

15,000 words (equivalent to 16 cps)

Minimum of 4-core foundation level units must be completed before attempting advanced level
