

Graduate Certificate of Divinity

Course Code 076017G

A six month program (max 2 years part-time) which aims to introduce candidates from a non-theology academic background to the world of theology and equip them with the research skills to undertake post-graduate study.

Each unit within this award is one semester in duration and worth 4 credit points - a normal full-time load for this course being 4 units/semester.

This course is aimed to prepare students to be a well-informed member of a church ministry team.

Prerequisites

Admission applications will be considered from applicants who have graduated with or qualified for (at least) a bachelor degree or equivalent qualification from an Australian university or other approved higher education provider - or study that is deemed by the Australian College of Theology as being the equivalent.

Units

- Biblical Studies and/or Christian Thought (2 Units)
- Electives (2 Units)
