A three-year program (max 9yrs part-time) with a balance of biblical, historical, theological and practical units. The project and electives allow for a variety of interests and study goals. The first year of study may be taken as the Graduate Diploma in Divinity. Each unit is one semester, a normal full-time load being 4 units/semester.
